

A short survey was displayed at the conclusion of the meeting and 49 attendees responded.


How long have lived in Keswick on the River?




What is your current community status?


How often would you like to receive updates from the HOA in the future?




communication from the HOA in the future?




Would you be interested in volunteering with the HOA?




How important is community beautification and landscaping (entrance features, shrub beds and mowing) to you?



How important is neighborhood weed control to you? Note: HOA can only control weeds on HOA property.




How important is winter maintenance (snow clearing) to you?




Recognizing the desire of the community for considerable beautification by way of extra plantings and maintenance that must be paid by residents, are you willing to pay a higher HOA fee?




How concerned are you about theft/crime in Keswick on the River?




Would you like to see a neighborhood watch created for Keswick in the River?




How safe do you feel Keswick on the River is for families with children?

Attendees concerns

- All the cars parked for days on end on Keswick Way that never seem to move. We can never park in front of our house.
- Rental properties that yards and sidewalks are barely maintained. ie: weeds and long grass in summer and poor snow removal and icy sidewalks in winter. I know city bi-laws can be called. It's just frustrating.
- Lots of speeding at the south end of Keswick Way and vehicles turning very sharp at Keswick Blvd.
- A potential increasing traffic through KOTR community after Ellerslie road closure.
- It would be great to develop more amenities like a rink, basketball court, and baseball diamond.
- Street parking by the Town home residents, parking on both sides of the road leaves very little space for two vehicles to cross and always creates the risk of children coming up from behind the cars unknowingly.
- Installing a camera at the water fountain or other deterrence so it is not consistently vandalized.
- There are a few homes (newer builds on Valleyside) that do not meet the architectural requirements. They have used light blue pastel color on the hardie, and another used red color hardie board. They should be re-painted for a cohesive neighborhood.
